

# Conditions of Entry the 2018 52<sup>nd</sup> OKLAHOMA INTERNATIONAL

## **MONOCHROME:**

1. We will allow monochrome images in Nature, Photojournalism, and PIDM. For Nature and Photojournalism, only grey scale black and white monochrome is allowed.
2. It is the choice of the Oklahoma International that **NO Monochrome image is eligible to be entered in the PIDC section** – any monochrome PIDC entry will be disqualified.
3. An image is Monochrome only if it gives the impression of having no color (i.e. contains only shades of gray (or any one color) which can include pure black and pure white); OR it gives the impression of being a greyscale image that has been toned in one color across the entire image. (For example, via Sepia, red, gold, etc.)

A greyscale or multi-colored image modified or giving the impression of having been modified by partial toning, multi-toning or by the inclusion of spot coloring does not meet the definition of monochrome and shall be classified as a color image.
